

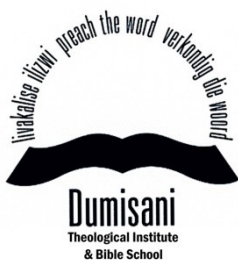

Certificate of Christian Foundations

The **CCF** is an **organised certificate of twelve courses** designed to provide foundational teaching in key areas:

- Christian life
- Skills
- Bible
- Ministry
- Christian Beliefs

It is *also* designed to be a helpful **foundation** for those who may choose to continue on with **further theological studies** following completion of the CCF.

Required Core Courses (eight)

Foundations of the Christian Life	This course begins with the foundation of the gospel in the Christian life and then explores the means to Christian growth and the formation of Christian character
Foundations of the Old Testament	To give the big perspective on the books, people, events and revelation of God in the OT through a quickly paced survey
Foundations of the Life & Teachings of Jesus Christ	To provide an overview of the life and teachings of Jesus Christ in the four Gospels
Foundations of Bible Study Principles	To help students grasp fundamentals of basic Bible interpretation for Bible studies, preaching or teaching
Foundations of College-level English	An introduction to strategies (with practice labs) for listening, speaking, reading and writing English at the college level
Foundations of Learning	This course integrates Study Skills and Library Skills. It is designed to help students to gain skills that will enable them to successfully approach college-level studies
Foundations of Computer Skills	For students new to the world of computers, this course is an introduction to computer vocabulary, Microsoft Word, internet research skills, and email. PowerPoint is offered as an optional unit
Foundations of Christian Beliefs (Doctrine)	To help the student know what makes for sound and healthy Christian belief and why

Electives (choose four – offered on a rotating basis – including others as announced)

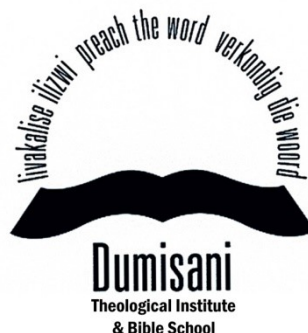
Foundations of Evangelism & Missions	Combines both biblical and practical teaching on evangelism and Christian missions
Foundations of Christian Public Speaking & Preaching	To help students become better Christian public speakers. Focusing upon the WHY, the WHAT, and the HOW of Christian public speaking and preaching
Foundations of Church Leadership & Management	An introduction to biblical principles and applications for church leadership and management
Foundations of Biblical Counselling	An introduction to biblical principles and applications in Christian counselling
Foundations of Church History	To introduce three key concepts: what is church history, why study church history, and a basic content of 2000 years of church history using a biographical approach
Foundations of Teaching Children	Do you want to become a better teacher of children? This course will help students acquire skills in lesson planning, lesson preparation and lesson delivery
Foundations of Christian Ethics	A basic overview of key biblical texts and their application in Christian moral life
Foundations of Church Life	An overview of biblical teaching on the nature of the Church as God's people and the essential characteristics of the life of a healthy church
Cults in Africa	An overview of the current cults present in Africa and their teachings. Students will be taught Biblical principles to respond to these heresies as well as Biblical principles for Christian character in interacting with unbelievers



Regulations:

- 1.** The CCF is designed to be completed in one year of full-time study or two years of part-time study. The CCF is a non-accredited programme offered by Dumisani Theological Institute and Bible School. Applicants for the CCF may apply to begin studies in any of the four terms.
- 2. a)** Individual courses in the CCF can also be taken as SHORT COURSES where the student does not have to enrol formally into the CCF.
b) All CCF courses taken as SHORT COURSES conclude with a Recognition of Achievement upon successfully completing all requirements for the SHORT COURSE.
- 3.** All registered CCF students who **successfully complete the twelve courses** and have upheld all Student Regulations will be invited to the annual Graduation and Awards Ceremony held in King William's Town to receive their CCF.
- 4.** All fees must be paid in full in order to graduate and receive your certificate. Also, all fees must be paid in full for SHORT COURSES in order to receive a Recognition of Achievement.
- 5.** The CCF/SHORT COURSES are normally offered over a seven-week term and four such terms are held each year at Dumisani in King William's Town.
- 6.** Students who believe their skills are such that they could be exempt from Foundations of College-level English and/or Foundations of Computer Skills may sit an examination in either or both. Failure to obtain a minimum grade on the examination means you are not exempt. Those who pass and receive exemption in one or both **MUST substitute** from the elective list in order to still complete 12 courses. Students interested in this option can obtain a "Request for Exemption Form" from the office.
- 7.** Tuition for all CCF/SHORT COURSES for 2019 is R450 per course. This fee includes course materials. Application fee for the CCF is R100. No application fee for the SHORT COURSES.
- 8.** Registration Fee for all CCF students – R100 per term.
