Greetings to you all in the wonderful name of our Lord and savior Jesus Christ.

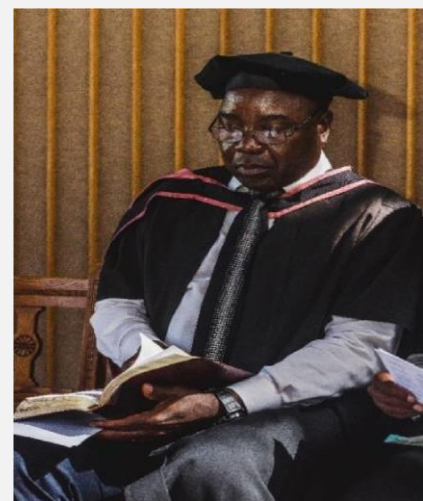
