

Dumisani Terms 3 & 4 Bursary Information for 2021 for senior level students

In 2016 we began our new Dumisani Bursary programme. This is an effort to assist senior, non-sponsored AMS or BTh students with their studies at Dumisani. Bursaries will be valued at between R1,000 and R 5,000 for 2021.

These bursaries are awarded in the second semester (Terms 3 & 4) and will be based upon merit, a demonstration of financial responsibility in semester one, and Christian character and is for non-sponsored AMS and BTh students only.

All student accounts must be fully paid for Terms 1 & 2 (Semester One) before consideration of a Terms 3 & 4 bursary will be given.

This Bursary programme will be limited to students who have done their first terms at Dumisani.

If a student drops out in the second semester and they have received a bursary that semester they forfeit the right to receive a bursary a second time from this Bursary Fund.
